

SSC offers support for all students



SSC (CAE)



Provides UA students a wide range of support directly related to their academic life and related to the **specific need**:



- Psychological
- Psychoeducational
- Socioeconomic
- Physical or sensorial disability



CAE – PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT

A team of social workers and psychologists work with students whose academic performance may be troubled by **different reasons**:

- ✓ Learning problems
- ✓ Hesitation in choosing a degree
- ✓ Concentration and memory difficulties
- ✓ Adaptation problems
- ✓ Conflicts with teaching staff
- ✓ Panic before exams





CAE - SOCIOECONOMIC SUPPORT (1)

Programme aiming to cover the basic needs of undergraduate students at UA, in relation to **financial unexpected issues as**:

- Problems occurring at the end of a scholarship
- Unachieved scholarships because of the low academic performance
- □ Economic independence and low income
- ■Serious illness or death of a parent
- □Delay in receiving scholarship payment
- □ Difficulties related to family breakups
- ■Refuse of scholarship because of residence permit





CAE- SOCIOECONOMIC SUPPORT (2)

Type of provided support:

- Professional guidance on available support and social mean at the UA and outside
- > Financial support for:
 - ✓ Meals at the UA
 - ✓ Transport to UA
 - ✓ Studing materials







CAE – SUPPORT FOR DISABLED STUDENTS

Students with any special need to develop their studies due to physical, sensory or any other disabilities will find support.

- Required adaptation to take the university entrance exam and to complete the online enrollment procedure
- > Accessibility in all spaces (classrooms, toilets, etc.
- Use of adapted means of transport and special parking spaces
- Professional help to follow lectures
- Volunteer work activities
- Career counseling to ensure complete integration at workspace, once finished the studies (in cooperation with GIPE)

CAE -other services



University enrollment support – free of charge

Assessment for teachers on how to teach students with specific needs (adapt their teaching programmes, materials, etc.)

Open doors for **volunteers**: to help students with special needs and/or to work in associations or social actions.

Social integration and **career development** at the end of the academic life

Created in 2003
